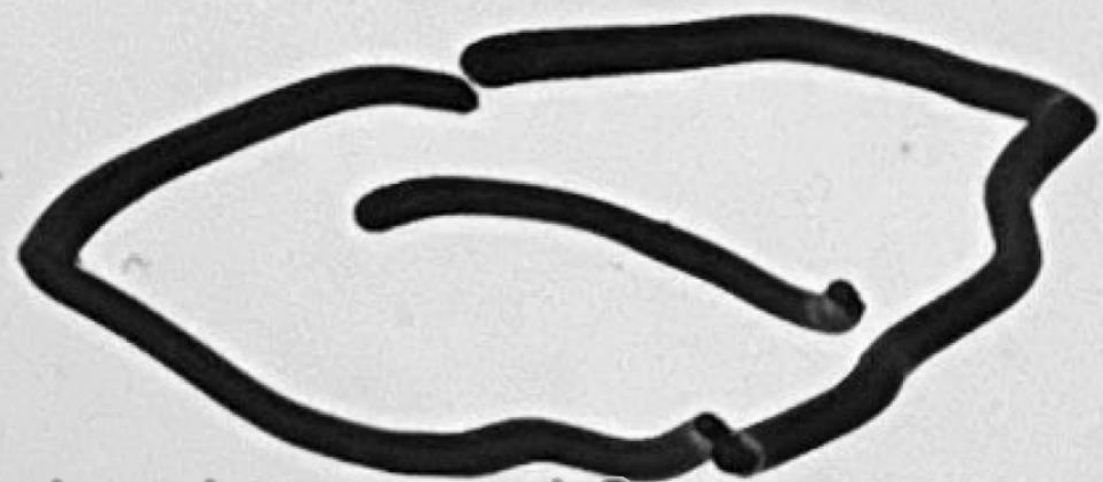


EXT. CLUB – Night

KEVIN walks a homeless man begging for change.

Friday Night Zombies

So, this became my inspiration for this short comedy horror film. INT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

KEVIN walks directly towards the cold drinks section.



INT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

Knowing what he wants, KEVIN opens the fridge door to take a bottle of energy drink.



INT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

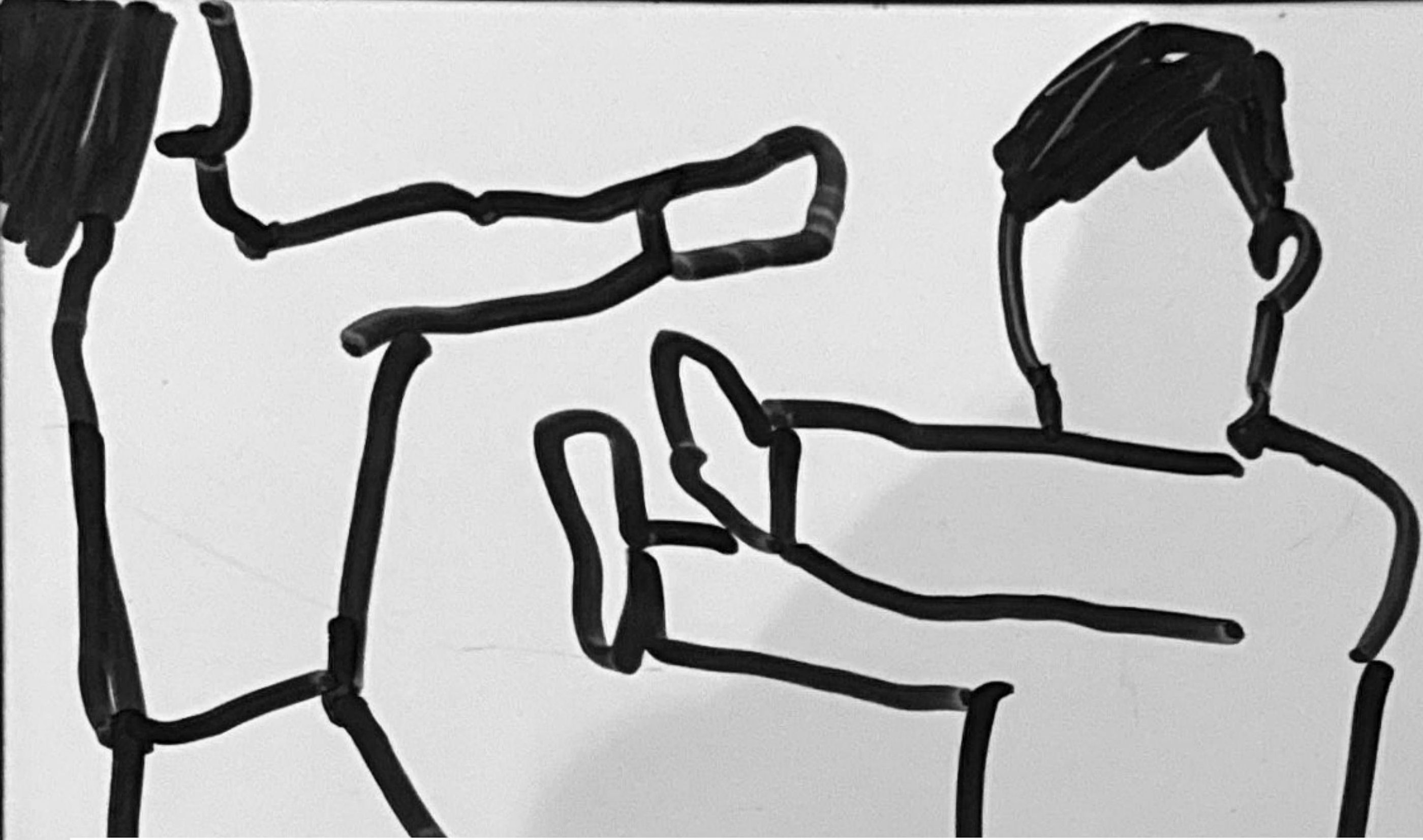
KEVIN places a few coins on the counter as the STORE CLERK opens the cashier machine and handed KEVIN the change.



EXT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

As KEVIN enters the store to get another drink, the DRUNKS who turns out to be zombies lunges at the homeless man and feeds on him.



EXT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

KEVIN gets himself another drink.



GOAL

I HOPE THE AUDIENCE COULD FEEL ENTERTAIN BY THIS SHORT COMEDY HORROR AS THEY FOLLOW KEVIN'S DRUNKEN ADVENTURE MISTAKING ZOMBIES AS DRUNKS. I WANT THE AUDIENCE TO FEEL ON THE EDGE AS KEVIN UNKNOWNLY DEALS WITH THE ZOMBIES.



EXT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

KEVIN exits the store and saw the ZOMBIES feeding on the homeless man.



EXT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

KEVIN drops the bottled drink on the road as he runs back towards the store.



INT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

Plot Point 2: KEVIN runs to the counter.



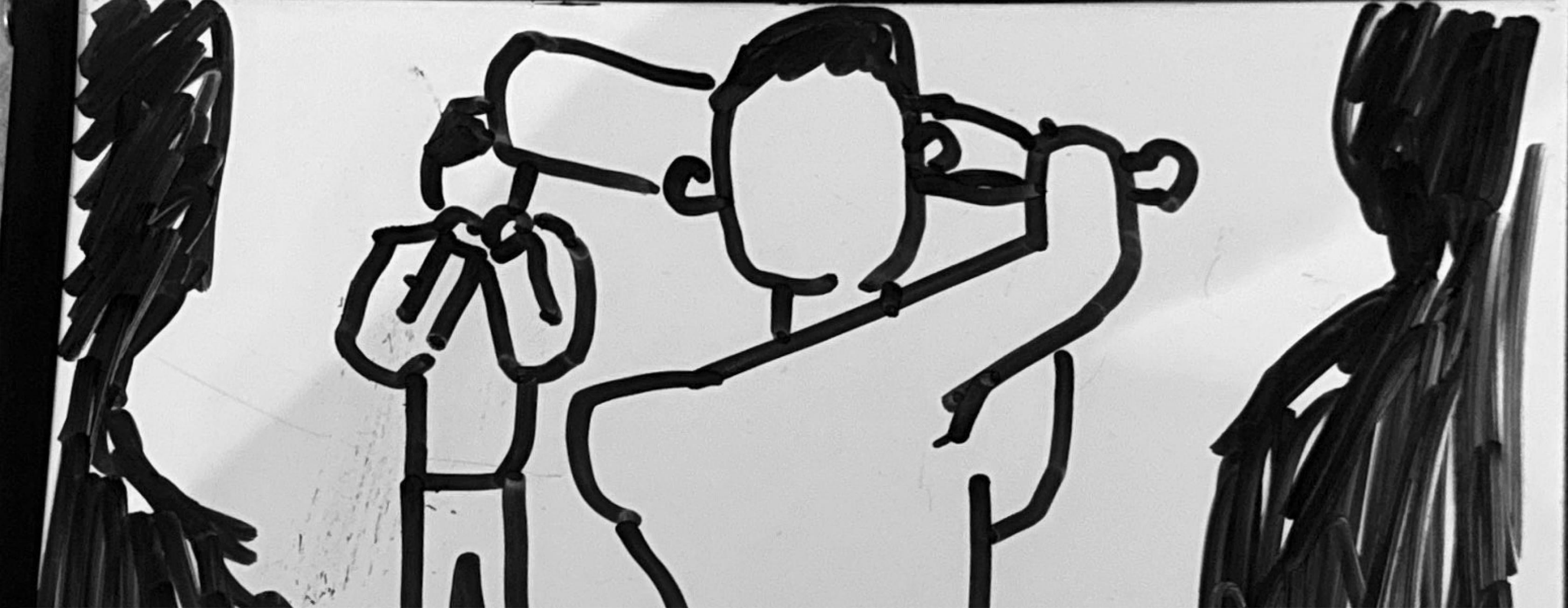
INT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

KEVIN points outside and stutters.



EXT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

The convenience store door opens, and the STORE CLERK exits with KEVIN following behind him.



EXT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

Climax: The STORE CLERK walks up to the ZOMBIES and without any hesitation swung the baseball bat.



EXT. CONVENIENCE STORE – NIGHT

Resolution: The STORE CLERK slings the baseball bat over his shoulders as he walks past KEVIN uttering
“another Friday night”.
